March 2015 - Flying-X Block

Key Block (1/5 actual size)

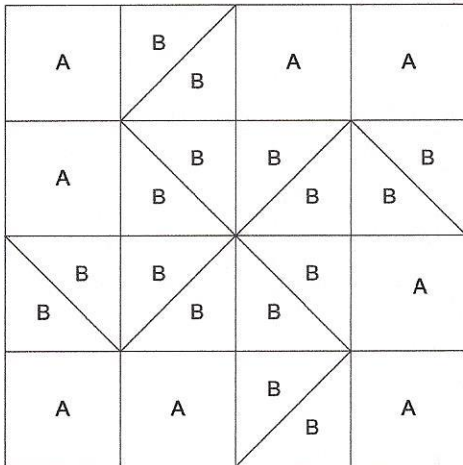

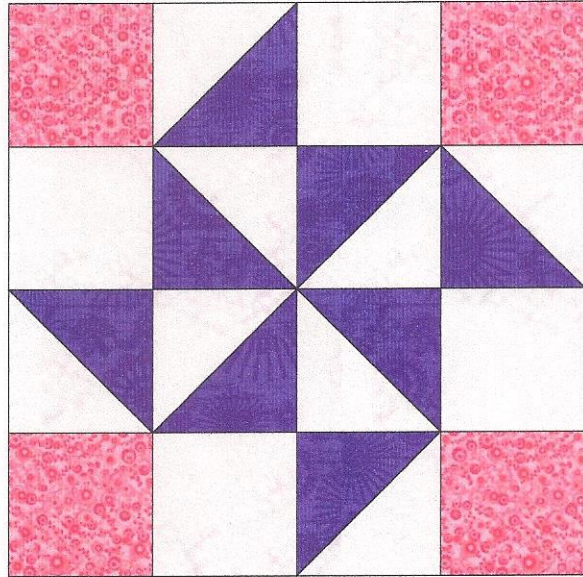

1. Cut four - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares of each pink and white-on-white (or white muslin).
2. Cut four - $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares of each purple and white-on-white (or white muslin) .
3. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner as shown on the back of the white-on-white.
4. Using the $3\frac{7}{8}$ " white and purple squares, place right sides together with white on top and sew on each side of the drawn diagonal using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam as shown by the dotted lines. (figure 3)
5. Cut along the drawn diagonal and press seam towards the purple.
6. You will now have sixteen $3\frac{1}{2}$ " patches which can be sewn together as shown above to create the Flying-X block.
7. The original 10" block is second from left on the bottom row of the quilt below.

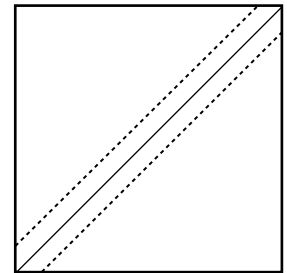
