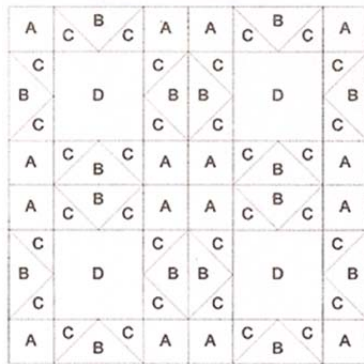


June Block of the Month – Four Star

Four Patch Variable Stars

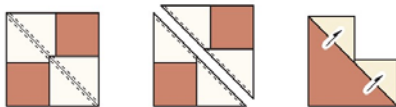
Key Block (5/20 actual size)



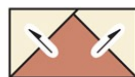
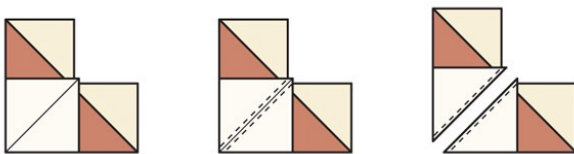
1. Cut 16 - 2" squares and 4 - 4 ¼" squares of white (or white on white background) .
2. Cut 1 - 3 ½" squares of each medium green, dark green, violet and dark pink.
3. Cut 4 - 2 ⅜" squares of each medium green, dark green, violet and dark pink.
4. Make four flying geese patches in each color using the instructions below.
5. Draw a line corner to corner on the back of each of the 2 ⅜" color patches as shown.
6. Place two same-color squares on each 4 ¼" background squares aligning drawn lines as shown.



7. Sew across squares ¼" on either side of the lines. Cut along drawn line and press away from background



8. Align the remaining same color square on each 'heart patch' as shown. Sew ¼" from each side of the drawn line and cut along drawn line. Press away from background and trim dog-ears.



9. Assemble each star as a 6 ½" unfinished nine-patch block , pressing toward centre color squares and small corner background squares.
10. Sew the four stars together to form block.
