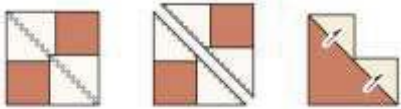


August Block of the Month – Whirlpool

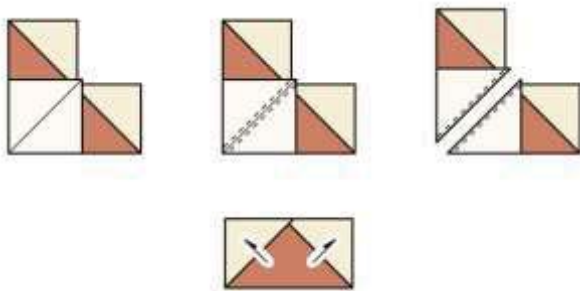
1. Cut 1 - 7 1/4" square of medium green.
2. Cut 4 - 3 7/8" squares of white background fabric and draw a line on the back of each square on the diagonal.
3. Cut 4 - 3 1/2" squares of each pink and white and draw a diagonal line on the back of each patch.
4. Cut 4 - 6 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles of dark green fabric.
5. Place two white squares on the 7 1/4" medium green square, right sides together, each aligning drawn lines as shown.



6. Sew across squares 1/4" on either side of the lines. Cut along drawn line and press away the from the green . Cut along the drawn line to give two heart patches.



7. Align the remaining white squares on each 'heart patch' as shown. Sew 1/4" from each side of the drawn line and cut along drawn line. Press away from green and trim dog-ears.



8. Place a white 3 1/2" square on a dark green rectangle, right sides together and matching edges. Sew along drawn line and finger press white open to form a white triangle. Place the pink square on the other end of each rectangle, sew along diagonal drawn line and finger press pink open to form a triangle. Press each rectangle and trim away the green and white/pink triangle below top pink/white triangle.

9. Sew the flying geese patches one to each dark green rectangle to form a square. Sew the squares together to form the block.
