

## Four X Star

1. Cut  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares as follows:

- 4 - dark green
- 1 - dark pink
- 4 - medium purple
- 8 - white background

2. Cut  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares as follows:

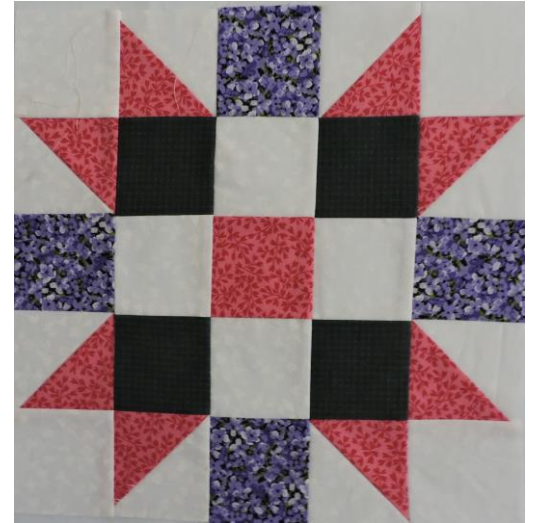
- 4 pink
- 4 white background.

Draw a diagonal line on the back of each of the white squares.

3. Place pairs of the white and dark pink squares from step 2 , right sides together.

4. Sew a seam  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from and either side of the diagonal line . Cut along the drawn line and press away from the white.

5. Sew the 5x5 block together as show in the photograph.



**NOTE:** Since this is a 5x5 block and measures 12" finished, make sure that you do **not use more than a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam**. The patches are  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " unfinished or  $2\frac{3}{8}$ " finished. A very accurate  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam will result in an  $11\frac{7}{8}$ " finished block **so make it a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam where possible**.
