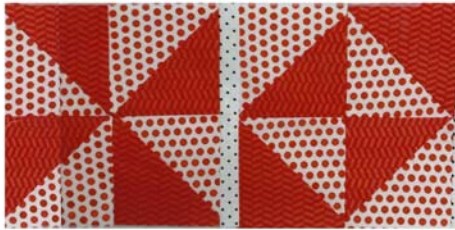
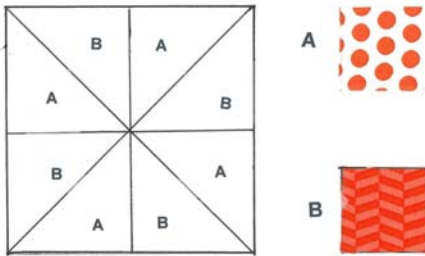


February 2017 BOM: Orange Pinwheel



Kit Cutting Directions:

Pieces for one block	Kit contains for 6 blocks	Directions
A 2 – 4" x 4 " squares	1- WOF @ 4" 1- 4" x 8"	Cut 10 – 4" squares Cut 2 - 4" squares
B 2 – 4" x 4 " squares	1- WOF @ 4" 1- 4" x 8"	Cut 10 – 4" squares Cut 2 - 4" squares
Optional Sashing between blocks	1 WOF @ 1"	Cut 5 – 6 ½" x 1" strips

For 1 block you need 4 Half-square triangles

For 6 blocks you need 24 Half-square triangles. Block are 6 ½" Unfinished

- Draw a diagonal line on the back of all **A** squares (lighter fabric).
- Place **A** over **B**, right sides together.
- Sew a scant ¼" on both sides of the diagonal line.
- Iron to set the seam. Cut apart on the diagonal line.
- Open and iron.
- Trim each unit to 3 ½" square.
- Sew 2 units together. Make 12 of these units.
- (Experiment with the arrangement. Not all the blocks have to be Pinwheels, or there do not have to be any Pinwheels) – this is your quilt!
- Sew top units to the bottom units to make 6 complete blocks.
- Trim blocks to 6 ½" square.

Optional: Sashing between blocks.

Sew strips between the 6 blocks.
