




April BOM(s) – (yes... pluran)
Block One – Old Maid's Puzzle
Block 12" finished, 12 ½ " unfinished





1. Cut 5 - 3 7/8" squares from background fabric (white muslin or white-on-white).
2. Cut 4 - 3 1/2" squares from background fabric (white muslin or white-on-white).
3. Cut 1 - 3 7/8" square of pink fabric.
4. Cut 2 3 7/8" squares of green fabric (grass green if possible).
5. Cut 1 - 6 7/8" square of medium purple fabric.
6. Draw a diagonal line on the back of 3 of the 3 7/8" background squares.



7. Place the single pink square right sides together with one of the marked background squares and stitch 1/4" away from each side of the diagonal line. Cut along the drawn line and press the half-square triangle patches with seam toward the color.
8. Repeat 7. with the other two marked background 3 7/8" squares and the green squares.
9. Using the green half-square patches and the 3 1/2" background squares , sew the patches to form the upper-left and lower-right four patch units.
10. Cut the remaining two background 3 7/8" squares along the diagonal. Sew one triangle to each side of the pink/white half-square triangle patch to form a large triangle. Do not press at this point.
11. Cut the large purple square along the diagonal and sew each triangle to the pink/white triangle along the hypotenuse (long side) to form a square. Press the seam toward the purple.
12. Sew the four created square patches to for the block which should measure 12 1/2 inches (unfinished)

April BOM(s) – BLOCK 2
Yankee Puzzle
Block 12” finished, 12 ½ “ unfinished



1. Cut 8 - 3 7/8" of background fabric (white-on-white or white muslin) and draw a diagonal line on the back of all these squares.
2. Cut 2 - 3 7/8" squares of each dark purple and green.
3. Cut 1 - 7 1/4" square of green.
4. Place two background squares right sides together with the large green square as shown. Sew across both background squares on either side of the drawn line using a 1/4 seam allowance as shown.
5. Cut long the drawn line and press away from the green giving two 'heart' patches.
6. Align another background square right sides together with the heart patch as shown and sew on either side of the drawn line.
7. Cut along the drawn line to form 2 'flying geese' units and press. Repeat with the other heart unit.
8. Place the remaining background squares right-sides together with the two green and the two purple squares. Sew either side of the drawn diagonals and cut along the solid line to give four purple and four green half-square triangle units.
9. Sew one purple and one green half-square triangle unit together and then sew them to a flying geese unit. Repeat for the other three sets. Sew the four 6 1/2" units together to create the block
