
July 2015 BOM

Duck and Ducklings Block 12" finished, 12 ½ " unfinished





- 1. Cut 4 2 7/8" background squares (white or white-on-white) and 5 2 7/8" dark pink squares.
- 2. Cut 2 5 5/8" squares in green and cut each square diagonally to give 2 triangles (for a total of four triangles).
- 3. Cut 2 3 1/4" purple squares and 6 3 1/4" background squares.
- 4. Draw a diagonal across the back of two of the white 3 1/4" squares.
- 5. Place the 2 purple squares right sides together with the 2 background (white squares) from the previous step. Sew on either side of the diagonal line using a 1/4" seam allowance.
 Cut along the diagonal line and finger-press the seam to the white.
- 6. Cut the remaining 3 1/4" background squares in half along a diagonal. Using a scant 1/4" seam, sew a white triangle to each side of the purple/white square to form a large triangle. Finger-press the seams to the purple.
- 7. Matching on the large diagonals, sew each green triangle to a white/purple triangle and finger-press the seams to the green.
- 8. Since all bias edges have now been sewn, it is safe to press the square using an iron.
- 9. Sew each white square to a pink square and press to the pink. Join one pink/white patch to either side of the remaining pink square.
- 10. Sew the remaining pink/white patches to the green/purple/white squares.
- 11. Sew the resulting patches to the long/pink/white patch to form the block.
