

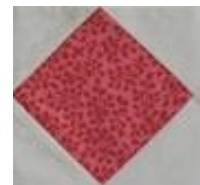
Ornate Star

1. Cut 1 - 4 1/2" square of medium pink.
2. Cut 4 - 3 3/8" squares of dark pink.
3. • Cut 1 - 5 1/4" square each of white background and light purple.
Cut 2 - 5 1/4" squares of medium purple.
• Draw a diagonal line on the back of each square on the diagonal.
• Then cut each square into four quarter-square triangles along the diagonals starting with the unmarked diagonal.



(The line is there to allow for accurate cutting if the fabric is moved between cutting the diagonals.)

4. Cut 8 - 2 7/8" squares of white background
Cut each into 2 half-square triangles along one of the diagonals.
5. Using the four dark pink squares from step 1 and the 16 white half-square triangles from step 4, sew 2 of the white triangles to either side of the four squares. (Center by folding and finger pressing a crease into the sides of the square and the long side of the triangles. Then match creases.) Press toward white. Repeat with the other two triangles to form the corner patches.



6. Sew a medium purple quarter square triangle to the short side of each of the light purple and white quarter square triangles from step 3. Take care with which side of the triangles you sew to make sure you will get the medium purple X's in step 7. Press the triangles away from white and light purple to allow seam nesting in the next step.
7. Sew the large triangles together to form the purple X's. Press away from white.
8. The block can now be put together as a normal nine patch.
