- January** **Becky Robinson** of Sew Suite will be on hand to talk about machine maintenance.
- February** **Beth Karr** will be joining us to do a lecture on One Block Wonders and present a trunk show. Her two day workshop is full and members are reminded to review her class supply list and that they will need either One Block Wonders or One Block Wonders Encore book. Encore is preferred as it includes all the cube designs.
- March** **No meeting** will be held because of the quilt show.
- April** Our **guild member Ben Smith** will be on hand to talk about his quilt journey and present a trunk show.
- May** Speaker cancelled and will be replaced. We will announce as soon as arrangements have been made. We will also celebrate our 35th year as a guild.
- June** **Becky Robinson** of Sew Suite will be on hand to present a lecture on using your quilting skills to make clothing. A **workshop** is in the works!
- July** **Paige Alexander** will be on hand to give us a lecture on Beginners Machine Quilting, basics of binding and show her quilts. A **workshop** called Arrows All Around and a small top will be pieced and machine quilted in class. This top can be a mini quilt or a pillow top. She will also provide training on how to do a proper binding. Great class for those who want to learn machine quilting basics! Workshop fee: \$50.00.
- August** **Jane McKenzie** will be on hand with a trunk show of her beautiful creations made of Australian and African fabrics. She's an accomplished quilter who will inspire us to move out of our comfort zone.
- September** **Susan Edmonson** – Lecture: "My Creative Journey". Susan will showcase her wonderful applique projects in her lecture I invite you to visit her website www.susanedmonsondesigns.com and see her creations made of wool, beads, ribbon and twigs. Her **workshop** on Friday will be on her Garden Girls pattern and is done by hand. No heavy machines to carry! There will be a \$10.00 pattern fee and there is a kit that is optional available for \$25.00. Workshop fee will be \$50.00.
- October** **Margaret Willingham** will be joining us giving her lecture "Quilting: A Creative Journey". Her website has stunning applique work that can be done by machine or by hand. Visit her website www.eobquiltdesign.com to see her phenomenal quilts. On Friday she will do a **workshop** on her Fleur de Lis block. This block can be hand or machine reverse applique. Five hours for those using a machine or eight by hand with a nearly finished piece by the time we leave. There is a pattern fee of \$9.00 and she will also have patterns for sale at the meeting. Workshop fee will be \$50.00.
- November** **Suzi Parron** will speak on "Following the Barn Quilt Trail" which she has written a book about. We will see the blocks from across the country and the stories behind them. There is a **two day workshop** where you can paint your favorite quilt block. The class fee is \$20.00 but you are responsible for paying her a \$45.00 supply fee at class. You will be provided with a primed 2' x 2' board, suggested patterns, paint, foam bushes, colored pencils and other tools. All you need to bring is painters tape (green frog tape is best), yard stick, pencil, blow dryer and covering for the table. Well, maybe for you too!
