
## GIANT BLOCK TUTORIAL SERIES February




Listed below are cutting instructions and a tutorial for making a 24" or 36" block. If you would like ideas on using these blocks in a quilt, check out the Giant Block Tutorial Series posts at kitchentablequilting.com.

These instructions are for making a single block. I made the example block in 2 colors, but you can use a single color or make the block scrappy.



	24" BLOCK	(6) 4" X 4"	(12) 4" X 4"	<ul> <li>(18) 4" × 4"</li> <li>(12) 3.5" × 3.5"</li> <li>(4) 6.5" × 6.5"</li> </ul>	
	36" BLOCK	(6) 5.5" X 5.5"	(12) 5.5" X 5.5"	<ul> <li>(18) 5.5" × 5.5"</li> <li>(12) 5" × 5"</li> <li>(4) 9.5" × 9.5"</li> </ul>	

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Make half square triangles using your desired method with the 4" squares for the 24" blocks and the 5.5" squares for the 36" blocks.




Sew together an A/C half square triangle (HST) and Fabric C square.




Piece together (2) A/C HSTs.

Sew together the shapes from the previous two steps and make the number indicated.



Sew together the pieces to complete the quilt block.



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
