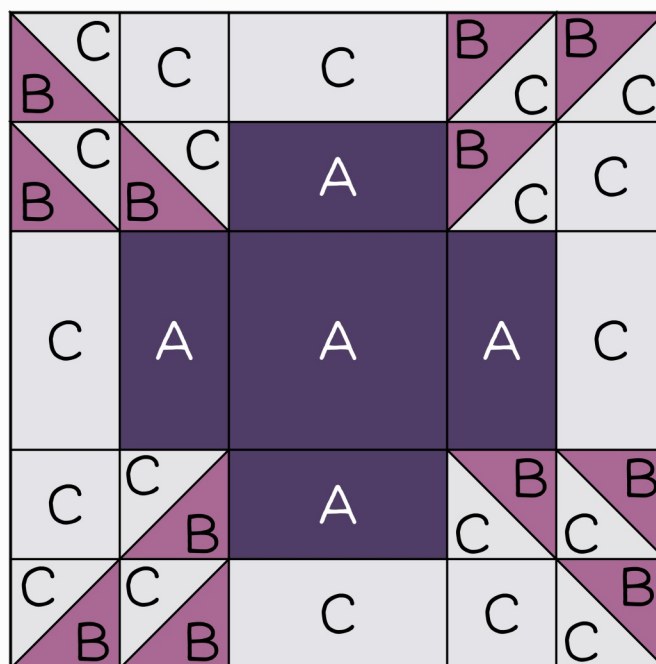


# GIANT BLOCK TUTORIAL SERIES

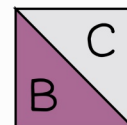

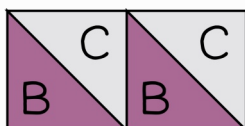
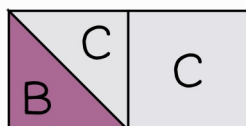
### CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

	A	B	C
24" BLOCK	(1) 8.5" X 8.5" (4) 4.5" X 8.5"	(6) 5" X 5"	(4) 4.5" X 4.5" (4) 4.5" X 8.5" (6) 5" X 5"
36" BLOCK	(1) 12.5" X 12.5" (4) 6.5" X 12.5"	(6) 7" X 7"	(4) 6.5" X 6.5" (4) 6.5" X 12.5" (6) 7" X 7"

1. Make (12) Fabric B/C half square triangles (HSTs) with the 5" squares for the 24" block and the 7" squares for the 36" block using your preferred method. Trim the HSTs for the 24" block down to 4.5" x 4.5" and the HSTs for the 36" block down to 6.5" x 6.5."

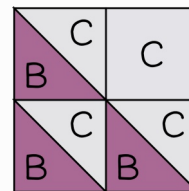
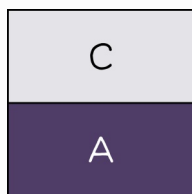

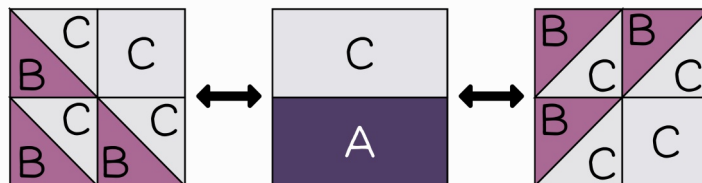
2. Sew an HST to a Fabric C square. Make 4.  
3. Sew 2 HSTs together. Make 4. Pay attention to the orientation of the HSTs in steps 2-3.

4. Sew a piece from step 2 to a piece from step 3. Make 4.

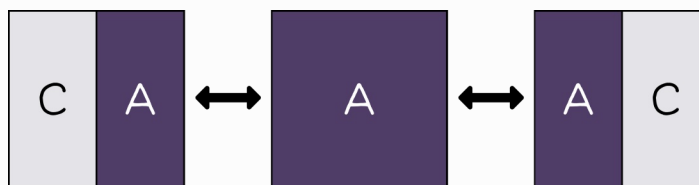


5. Sew a Fabric A rectangle to a Fabric C rectangle. Make 4.

6. Sew a square from step 5 in between 2 squares from step 4, making sure that the orientation of the pieces is like shown below. Make 2.



7. Sew the Fabric A square between 2 squares from step 5.



8. Sew together the block.
