Established in 1983, the purpose of the Cobblestone Quilters Guild is to foster the art of quilting, to encourage a high standard of design and technique in all of its various forms, and to stimulate an interest in these goals within the Tri-County community.

Meetings: Meetings consist of a brief business report, and activities including Quilters Treasure, Quilters Treasure Drawing, Program, and Show and Tell. The Quilters Treasure table, Ways and Means, and Block of the Month are available approximately 30 minutes before the meeting begins.

Programs: Our Program Committee presents interesting and informative programs each month. Several times a year we bring in nationally known teachers who present a lecture and offer classes. In the recent past we have presented Kathy McNeil, Carol Jaynes, Debbie Maddy, Pat Yamin, Beth Karr, David Gilleland, Susan Edmondson, Augusta Cole, Deb Heatherly, Elaine Quehl, Marilyn Wall.

We offer hands-on programs featuring accomplished quilters from our guild, and invite speakers from the community to talk on topics of interest to the members. Classes may be offered by some of our program guests. Financial assistance scholarships are available to guild members on a confidential basis. Requests can be mailed to the Guild's Post Office Box and with the envelope marked "Scholarship Program", or contact the Guild President or Scholarship Chairperson. Community Outreach: Each year our guild chooses a charity to support, usually supporting women and/or children. We have made quilts for the Lowcountry Firefighters Support, Doors to Freedom, Florence Crittenton Home, My Sister's House, Ronald McDonald House, HALOS, SPCA, nursing homes and many more!

Block Of The Month: A Block of the Month program is offered each year.

Show And Tell: Members and visitors bring their finished projects for all to admire and inspire.

Quilters Treasure: Each month the members contribute interesting items such as fat-quarters of fabric, and "whatsits" for the treasure. Tickets are sold and participation in meeting activities earns tickets for drawings of the treasure packages. Ticket sales fund the scholarships for classes.

The Guild also sponsors other activities that do not occur at our regular meetings:

Biennial Quilt Show: The Guild sponsors a biennial quilt show which occurs in the spring of even years. In lieu of our own show, in 2019 and 2020 Cobblestone Quilters Guild is supporting the American Quilters Society's (AQS) "Quilt Week Charleston".

Quilters' Day Out: Usually three times a year we have informal Saturday gatherings to work on a special project. Participants are welcome to bring their own project to work on as well.

Beach Retreat: A weekend retreat held on on Seabrook Island at Camp St. Christopher once each year. Participants bring their own projects. Space is limited and fills early.

Coastal Carolina County Fair Quilt Show: The guild coordinates with the Coastal Carolina County Fair to provide prizes for this fun quilt show. Members volunteer at the show to help spread the art of quilting.
