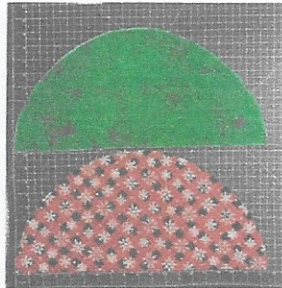
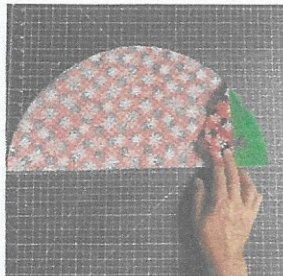


Christmas Tree Napkin

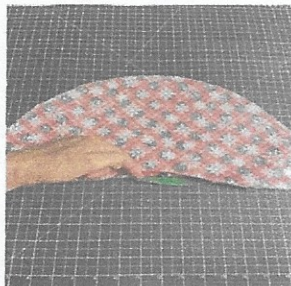
1. Print out paper templates, tape the 3 sheets together, matching lines.
2. Select two contrasting fabrics. (at least 19 X 20 inches)



3. Place fabric right sides together and trace around template, then cut your two layers at the same time.

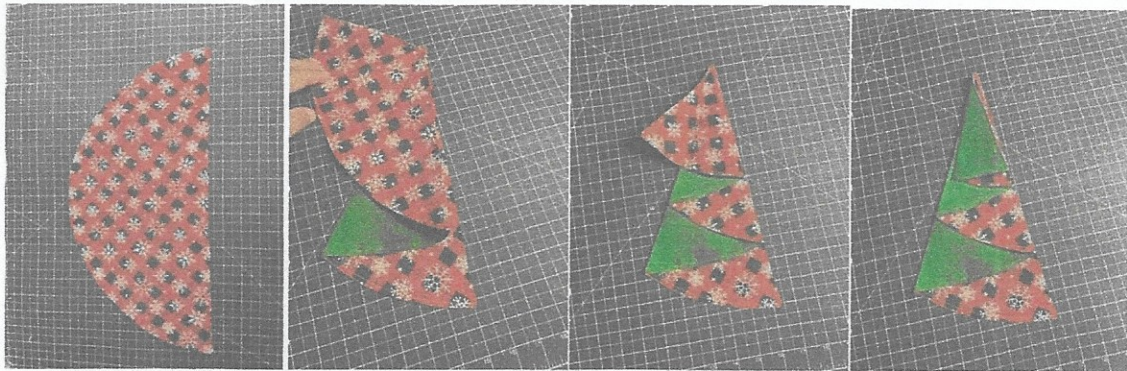


4. Start stitching $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam from the 4-inch opening marks and stop at the second opening mark.



5. Once you sew all the way around leaving the opening for turning it right-side out, trim the two lower corner (do not clip your seam thread), then snip the seam allowance on the curve to make it smooth when you turn it right-side out.

6. Now that you have a sewn half circle, you will go to the opening you left and turn one side in $\frac{1}{4}$ inch and lightly press it, next you will match the other side and do the same.
7. After you have pressed the opening, you will top stitch a 1/8-inch seam all the way around the napkin edge, making sure you catch the two edges of the opening to secure the opening shut. (you can use a decorative stitch or decorative thread.)
8. Place your napkin back on your paper template and with a chalk pencil or heat pen mark the first fold / stitch line and the second stitch line. Sew a top stitch on those lines. (This will give you a set fold line for when you wash and press the napkins in the future)
9. You are ready to fold the napkin, fold the napkin on the first fold line and press the seam. Now flip your napkin over and accordion fold your second fold even with the edge of the napkin, the 3rd fold should match up with the 2nd stitch line you put on the napkin, then continue in the same manner for the 4th and 5th folds. Make sure to press the folds (you can use starch to insure a crisp edge).

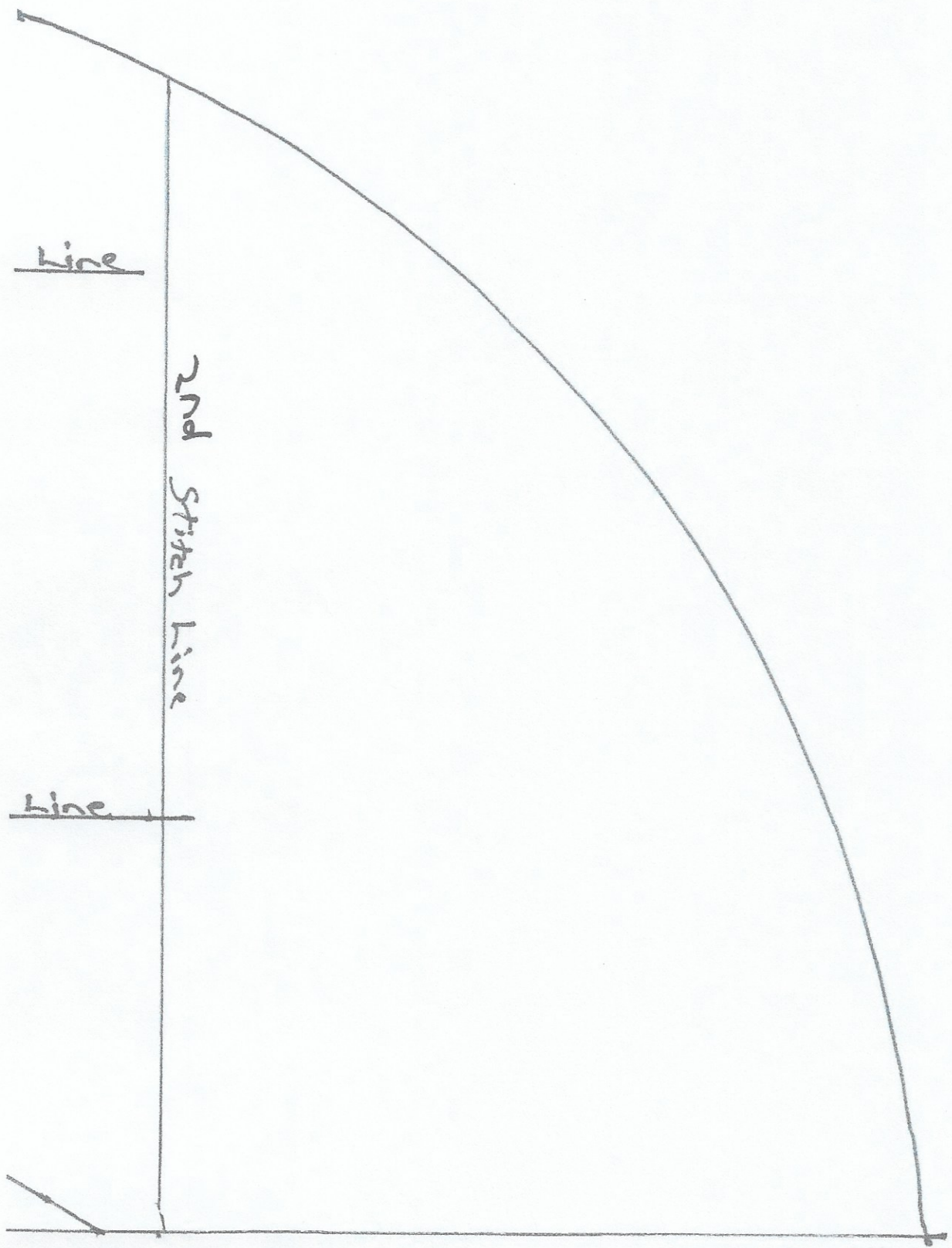

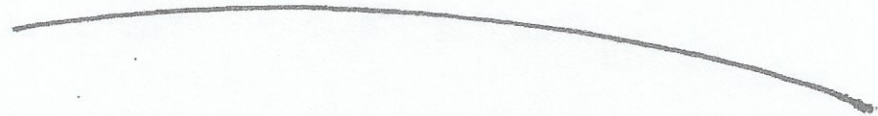
